Prof. Indra Dasgupta obtained his Bachelor's degree with Physics (Honours) from Presidency College, Calcutta, Master's in Physics from IIT Kanpur and PhD degree from Calcutta University based on a work done at S.N. Bose National Centre for Basic Sciences, Kolkata on Theoretical Condensed Matter Physics. After completing his doctoral studies he was a post-doctoral research associate at Max Planck Institute for Solid State Research in Stuttgart, Germany. He subsequently worked at IIT Bombay, IIT Kharagpur before joining Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science (IACS), Jadavpur Kolkata in 2007. He is presently a Senior Professor and Dean Faculty Affairs and Research & Development at IACS. He held visiting positions in various premier research institutes like Kavli Institute of Theoretical Physics, Santa Brabara, USA, Uppsala University, Sweden, University of Paris Sud, Orsay France, University of Missouri Columbia, USA, International Centre for Theoretical Physics (ICTP), Trieste etc. He is presently the council member from India at Asia Pacific Centre for Theoretical Physics (APCTP) Pohang, Korea and recipient of Max Planck Stipendium, the excellence in Teaching Award from IIT Bombay and MRSI medal from Material Research Society of India.
